

**The ACT'S PLAN Test for BK 10<sup>th</sup> grade students will be given on  
Wednesday, October 12, 2011**

Taking PLAN is a great way to prepare for the ACT. In fact, students who take PLAN tend to score higher on the ACT than students who do not take PLAN.

It covers the same subjects—English, mathematics, reading, and science—and provides an estimated ACT score. PLAN points out academic strengths and areas where improvement is needed and lets students know if they're on track for college.

PLAN helps students find careers that match their interests and can even help connect them with colleges interested in them.

**We will start promptly at 8 o'clock. Please be on time. Students should be completed with testing shortly after 11:30 a.m.**

**What to bring:**

- Two #2 sharpened pencils
- Calculator – check your batteries! No batteries will be available (*you must have this for the math section*)
- Snack - (the cafeteria will be closed)
- A book to read when you complete the test (you will not be allowed to go to your locker while others are testing)

**Dress Code:** Regular dress code

**What not to bring:** All other electronic devices
