



BK Committee Launches Search for New School President

Dr. David Lachiondo's Retirement Planned at End of Current School Year

An important transition has begun at BK, and we thought it was important to let you know just what is taking place.

A Presidential Search Committee has begun work to identify potential candidates to assume the position of President of Bishop Kelly High School. The recruiting effort follows the announcement by Dr. David Lachiondo that he will retire at the end of the school year after an 18-year career at Bishop Kelly.

The Search Committee, headed by Tim LaMott, has developed a job description and is undertaking a local, regional and national outreach effort to identify qualified, Catholic applicants for the position. Applications will be accepted until December 18, 2009, and the Search Committee plans to identify candidates to recommend to the Bishop Kelly Board of Governance by the first quarter of 2010.
