

Dear Parents:

A reminder that **Wednesday, October 12th** , is **Testing Day** for Freshmen, Sophomores, and Juniors. Due to the important nature of this day, there will be NO RELEASES for any Doctor, Orthodontic, or other types of appointments from 8:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. We will not be interrupting the testing environment to deliver student messages or release messages.

If you already have a pre-scheduled appointment that you do not want to re-schedule, your student may leave during one of the short breaks between tests. They will not be able to finish their test, but will receive results on the portion that they did complete. However, you may want to consider re-scheduling the appointment. You can expect the results in mid-November. This test data will be used to improve our curriculum for all students.

We will start promptly at 8 o'clock. Please be on time. Students should be completed with testing shortly after 11:30.

What to bring:

- Two #2 sharpened pencils
- Calculator – check your batteries! No batteries will be available (*you must have this for the math section*)
- Snack - (the cafeteria will be closed)
- A book to read when you complete the test (you will not be allowed to go to your locker while others are testing)
