Blackboard - We have an exciting new resource this year called Blackboard.

- There will be Blackboard training for parents on the following dates: Tuesday, Sept. 1 at 3:30 p.m.; Wednesday, Sept. 9 at 3:30 p.m.; and Saturday, September 12 at 10 a.m. Please attend one of these dates and learn how to use Blackboard.
- Blackboard is an online classroom management system. Teachers will be using it in their classrooms to enhance the learning environment and improve communication between teachers and students and teachers and parents.
- Bishop Kelly is using a blended model of instruction, which means that students will still receive high-quality instruction in person, and it will be complimented by materials online through Blackboard.
- All freshman parents have been given access to the system. They will have a unique user ID and password, which will enable them to log in and see what students are doing in class. Parents of non-freshmen can request access to the system. This may be especially helpful for student who struggle academically, and it can help reinforce learning at home.

Health - Letter from our School Nurse:

Dear Parents and Students:

Welcome back to a new school year! If you have not already done so, please let me know if your child has a medical condition which may impact them at school, such as food allergies, asthma, chronic conditions, etc. This information is confidential. I prefer to keep a rescue inhaler in my office for each asthma patient's emergency use, as well as an epi-pen for those with severe allergies. If your student will be taking medication during the school day, I have a form that authorizes the school to dispense these medications.

At Bishop Kelly, we strive to maintain a healthy atmosphere for student learning. We will be proactive in trying to keep flu and other illnesses from spreading. If your student is ill, please do not send them to school. Remind your students that **not** sharing food and water bottles, as well as good hand washing, is essential for stopping the spread of germs. In addition, please remind your student that if they become ill at school, they need to see the nurse first. They should not text or call a parent to pick them up before they are seen by the nurse. Let's have a healthy start to our school year!

If Your Child is Absent from School:

If your student is not coming to school due to illness or an appointment, parents are required to call the school's Attendance Office by 9:30 am, 377-9928. Parents may also e-mail or fax notes to Mrs. Lisa Kelly for excused absences at lkelly@bk.org. The BK fax is 375-3626. If your child is going to be absent from school for an extended amount of time, please contact the attendance office as soon as possible prior to the absence. Pre-arranged absence forms are available from Mr. Coulter for Juniors/Seniors and Mrs. Quilici for Freshman/Sophomores. These will allow students to notify teachers and to receive homework assignments before the absence. Note: Students leaving school for professional appointments must notify the Attendance Office **before** school, when they leave, and again when they return. They will be asked for verification of that appointment upon returning to school. ***All students are required to sign in and out when coming late or leaving early.

How Can I Access My Child's Grades?

You can access your student's grades and other information on the Internet. You need your student's ID number and PIN number. Your child's PIN and ID are located on the class schedule they received the first day of school. The PIN number is assigned throughout our Schoolmaster Program. It's important to keep this number confidential. If you would like to get your student's PIN number, please e-mail administrator@bk.org with the student's full name. Go to the BK web page at www.bk.org and access Schoolmaster; use your student's ID number and PIN, and you will have his/her grades and records. Our teachers upgrade their records regularly, but not nightly. To access current grades on Schoolmaster, please follow these instructions.

1. Go to the Bishop Kelly website, www.bk.org.
2. Select **Schoolmaster** from the menu choices.
3. Enter your student's ID and PIN numbers in the appropriate boxes.
4. Click **Current Marks** in the list of choices.
5. If you want to see a progress report and more detailed information, follow steps 1, 2 and 3, then select **Schedule/Progress** from the list of choices. Teachers update these marks approximately every two weeks. Some teachers may update more frequently than others.
