## From the School Nurse:

Dear Parents and Students:

You are, no doubt, hearing numerous reports of Swine Flu cases in the Boise and Meridian school districts. A definitive diagnosis of H1N1 takes time, as the sample must be sent to the CDC. At BK, we are taking a proactive approach to decreasing germ transmission by stepping up daily cleaning routines and encouraging staff and students to observe the following basic behaviors:

1. If you are sick, **STAY HOME**. If you have been ill with a fever, you must be fever-free for 24 hours before returning to school.
2. **Wash your hands!** This has been proven to be the single most effective behavior in stopping germ transmission.
3. Sneeze into your sleeve or your hand. Be sure to wash your hands after doing so.
4. Take care of yourself and family members. Get enough sleep, eat a nutritious diet, exercise regularly.

Our community may be hard hit with both the H1N1 and seasonal flu viruses. It is up to all of us to practice healthy habits in an effort to keep the viruses from spreading. To that end, I will be sending home information regarding flu vaccines for students within the next two weeks. Please watch for the information in BK Alive.

**Cross Country** – Congratulations to the Bishop Kelly cross country teams on their outstanding performances at the Tiger-Grizz Invitational in Idaho Falls and the Weiser Invite over the past week. First to Weiser and the JV girls' race where gold medal winner, Joan Cleary, and Bailey Russell 3<sup>rd</sup>, led the charge for a dominating Knight performance to easily capture the team title. Considering having less than 20 minutes to warm-up, both teams performed admirably and recorded many season bests. Sadly, meet officials were not able to complete the results and many brilliant performances will go unrecorded. However, the effort by all was tremendous and the improvement rate of our JV squad gets better and better; and without a shadow of a doubt, they will be hot contenders to retain both district championships of a year ago. Ben Fujii and Kyle Kiehn contested a great battle in the men's race and were honored with 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placings.

Switching to Idaho Falls, the varsity girls led by a magnificently courageous effort from runner-up Emily Nist and fine individual performances from Captain Lara Tuthill in 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> respectively, finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> in a loaded 26 team field. Tremendous team packing was the order of the day and the Knights took fun advantage of the superb competition. Sophomores Briana Tiffany, Erin Gordon, Amanda Thompson and junior Erin Kelly finish 23<sup>rd</sup> through 26<sup>th</sup> with just a 7 second gap. It was an excellent performance by them to finish so high up the top class field. Wonderful to see Emily and the Knights be recognized on [www.Dyestat.com](http://www.Dyestat.com) running website this week as they continue to climb and push for a spot on the top 10 Northwest Regional rankings.

On the varsity boys, sophomore Dan Williams turned in one of the best ever displays by a Knight uniform. Taking a top 10 placing from the start, Dan moved nicely through the field with a stylish relaxed, yet powerful, display of cross country running. Claiming the runner-up award was deservedly announced on Dyestat.com and in the process helps the knights to a 13<sup>th</sup> place Northwest Regional ranking. Travis Milburn continues his stellar season by shaving off a minute from his time last season. Conor Harris returned to form with gutsy effort, and Gabe Leis ran on gamely to finish 31<sup>st</sup>. Returning to form and 800m specialist Andrew Chumich rounded out the top 5 for the Knights with D.J. Corisis and Matt Goodwin battling throughout and finishing excellently in the top 70. The varsity men continue to improve with each week, thus leaving the coaching staff very excited indeed. Ashlynn Curnow ran to an easy victory in the JV girl's race after a hugely impressive performance. Kat Stidham and Stephanie Souza had their best performance of the season and looked very solid indeed. In the JV men's race, sophomore Matt Burke really excited the coaches with his best race to date, as did Joey Cardona, Zach Klein, fast improving Jimmy Harrison and Levi Drauszewski. The JV men ran courageously throughout the 5km trip and were rewarded with excellent placings.

### **If Your Child is Absent from School:**

If your student is not coming to school due to illness or an appointment, parents are required to call the school's Attendance Office by 9:30 am, 377-9928. Parents may also e-mail or fax notes to Mrs. Lisa Kelly for excused absences at [lkelly@bk.org](mailto:lkelly@bk.org). The BK fax is 375-3626. If your child is going to be absent from school for an extended amount of time, please contact the attendance office as soon as possible prior to the absence. Pre-arranged absence forms are available from Mr. Coulter for Juniors/Seniors and Mrs. Quilici for Freshman/Sophomores. These will allow students to notify teachers and to receive homework assignments before the absence. Note: Students leaving school for professional appointments must notify the Attendance Office **before** school, when they leave, and again when they return. They will be asked for verification of that appointment upon returning to school. \*\*\*All students are required to sign in and out when coming late or leaving early.

### **How Can I Access My Child's Grades?**

You can access your student's grades and other information on the Internet. You need your student's ID number and PIN number. Your child's PIN and ID are located on the class schedule they received the first day of school. The PIN number is assigned throughout our Schoolmaster Program. It's important to keep this number confidential. If you would like to get your student's PIN number, please e-mail [administrator@bk.org](mailto:administrator@bk.org) with the student's full name. Go to the BK web page at [www.bk.org](http://www.bk.org) and access Schoolmaster; use your student's ID number and PIN, and you will have his/her grades and records. Our teachers upgrade their records regularly, but not nightly. To access current grades on Schoolmaster, please follow these instructions.

1. Go to the Bishop Kelly website, [www.bk.org](http://www.bk.org).
2. Select **Schoolmaster** from the menu choices.
3. Enter your student's ID and PIN numbers in the appropriate boxes.

4. Click **Current Marks** in the list of choices.

5. If you want to see a progress report and more detailed information, follow steps 1, 2 and 3, then select **Schedule/Progress** from the list of choices. Teachers update these marks approximately every two weeks. Some teachers may update more frequently than others.
