SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS NOW BEING ACCEPTED – The Idaho State Board of Education Student Affairs office would like to notify current high school seniors that the window to complete online scholarship applications will close on **January 16, 2012**. *“It’s imperative that students do their work now in order to be eligible for funds later,”* said Dana Kelly, Program Manager for the Idaho State Board of Education. *“Especially in these lean economic times, students and their families need all the help they can get. This is the first step.”*

High school seniors need to log on to the Board’s web site at www.boardofed.idaho.gov/scholarships and follow the links provided. The deadline for completion of the online application is January 16, 2012.

Governor’s Cup Scholarship applications must printed and mailed, along with all supplemental materials required, to the Office of the State Board of Education - postmarked by January 20, 2012.

New Attendance Procedure: Parents, we have a **NEW** Attendance procedure at Bishop Kelly! In order to minimize classroom interruptions, we are no longer delivering PTL’s (permit to leave) to classrooms. If your student has an appointment during the school day, they will need to stop by the Attendance Office to pick up their PTL slip. They may do this before school, at break, or at lunch.

Please try to schedule appointments after school hours. Students arriving late to class or leaving class early disrupt the classroom. If your student must leave campus early (including 7th period), call or email the night before or as early in the day as possible to let us know so that the student can pick up their PTL (permit to leave) before going to class. It is the STUDENT’S responsibility to pick up their PTL at the Attendance Office before school, at break or at lunch. We do not interrupt the classrooms to deliver the Permit to Leave passes. (PTL pass). If you cannot call or email and choose to come to the office to pick up your student, please allow plenty of time for us to get the student out of class. Classes are not always in the assigned classrooms, or if the student is in a P.E. class he/she will need time to change clothing. It is always best to call first. Thank-you!

If Your Child is Absent from School

If your student is not coming to school due to illness or an appointment, parents are required to call the school's Attendance Office by 9:30 a.m. at 377-9928. Parents may also e-mail or fax notes to Mrs. Lisa Kelly for excused absences at lkelly@bk.org. The BK fax is 375-3626. If your child is going to be absent from school for an extended amount of time, please contact the attendance office as soon as possible **prior** to the absence. Pre-arranged absence forms are available from Mr. Coulter for Juniors/Seniors and Mrs. Emerich for Freshmen/Sophomores. These forms will allow students to notify teachers and to receive homework assignments **before** the absence.

Note: Students leaving school for professional appointments must notify the Attendance Office **before** school, when they leave, and again when they return. They will be asked for verification of that appointment upon returning to school. *****All students are required to sign in and out when coming late or leaving early. The attendance office is now in a portable behind the cafeteria.**

How Can I Access My Child's Grades?

You can access your student's grades and other information on the Internet. You will need your student's ID number and PIN number. Your child's PIN and ID are located on the class schedule they received the first day of school. The PIN number is assigned throughout our Schoolmaster Program. It is important to keep this number confidential. **If you would like to get your student's PIN number, please contact the main office at 375-6010.**

Go to the BK web page at www.bk.org and select the **SchoolMaster button**; use your student's ID number and PIN number, click on **Schedule/Progress**, and you will have his/her grades and records. Our teachers upgrade their records regularly, but not nightly.

To access current grades on Schoolmaster, please follow these instructions:

1. Go to the Bishop Kelly website, www.bk.org.
2. Select **SchoolMaster** from the yellow buttons on the bottom right-hand side of the home page.
3. Enter your student's ID and PIN numbers in the appropriate boxes.
4. Click **Current Marks** in the list of choices.
5. If you want to see a progress report and more detailed information, follow steps 1, 2 and 3, and then select **Schedule/Progress** from the list of choices. Teachers update these marks approximately every two weeks. Some teachers may update more frequently than others.
